

The Wicked Destroy Themselves

What you sow, you shall reap, corruption or life everlasting:

Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. 8) For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

The curse without a cause shall not come.

Proverbs 26:2 As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

Guilt and shame slew Christ.

Matthew 26:38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.

Psalms 88:3 For my soul is full of troubles: and my life draweth nigh unto the grave.

Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put Him to an open shame.

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Guilt and shame will slay the wicked.

Psalms 6:10 Let all mine enemies be ashamed and sore vexed: let them return and be ashamed suddenly.

Psalms 34:4 Let them be confounded and put to shame that seek after my soul: let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt. 5) Let them be as chaff before the wind: and let the angel of the LORD chase them. ... 26 Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify themselves against me.

Psalms 37:14 The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, and to slay such as be of upright conversation. 15) Their sword shall enter into their own heart, and their bows shall be broken.

Psalms 40:14 Let them be ashamed and confounded together that seek after my soul to destroy it; let them be driven backward and put to shame that wish me evil. 15) Let them be desolate for a reward of their shame that say unto me, Aha, aha.

Psalms 83:13 O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind. 14) As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire; 15) So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm. 16) Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD. 17) Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish:

Psalms 44:7 But thou hast saved us from our enemies, and hast put them to shame that hated us.

Psalms 70:3 Let them be turned back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha.

Psalms 71:24 My tongue also shall talk of thy righteousness all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought unto shame, that seek my hurt.

Psalms 109:29 Let mine adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle.

Proverbs 13:5 A righteous man hateth lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and cometh to shame.

Ezekiel 7:18 They shall also gird themselves with sackcloth, and horror shall cover them; and shame shall be upon all faces, and baldness upon all their heads. 19) They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumblingblock of their iniquity.

The wicked rebel against God.

Psalms 81:11 But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me. 12) So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: and they walked in their own counsels.

Psalms 5:10 Destroy thou them, O God; let them fall by their own counsels; cast them out in the multitude of their transgressions; for they have rebelled against thee.

Proverbs 1:24 Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded; 25) But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof: 26) I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh; 27) When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you. 28) Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me: 29) For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD: 30) They would none of my counsel: they despised all my reproof. 31) Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices. 32) For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.

God gives the expected end.

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

Expected H 8615 from 6960; literally, a **cord** (as an **attachment** (compare 6961)); figuratively, expectancy:—expectation ((-ted)), hope, live, thing that I long for.

Psalms 62:5 My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from Him.

Psalms 62:1 Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from Him cometh my salvation.

Proverbs 11:23 The desire of the righteous is only good: but the expectation of the wicked is wrath.

Proverbs 8:36 But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.

Proverbs 5:22 His own iniquities shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins.

Evil shall slay the wicked.

Psalms 7:9 Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the just: for the righteous God trieth the hearts and reins.

Psalms 34:21 Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate.

Psalms 94:23 And He shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off.

Psalm 9:15 He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch which he made. 16) His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate.

Psalm 10:2 The wicked in his pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken in the devices that they have imagined.

Psalm 64:3 Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words: ... 7) But God shall shoot at them with an arrow; suddenly shall they be wounded. 8) So they shall make their own tongue to fall upon themselves: all that see them shall flee away. 9) And all men shall fear, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of His doing. 10) The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in Him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

Psalm 94:23 And He shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off.

Psalm 140:9 As for the head of those that compass me about, let the mischief of their own lips cover them. 10) Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again. 11) Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow him.

Psalm 141:10 Let the wicked fall into their own nets, whilst that I withal escape.

Proverbs 11:5 The righteousness of the perfect shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness. 6) The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them: but transgressors shall be taken in their own naughtiness.

Ezekiel 22:31 Therefore have I poured out mine indignation upon them; I have consumed them with the fire of my wrath: their own way have I recompensed upon their heads, saith the Lord GOD.

Romans 2:5 But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;
